Your child is a COVID close contact, now what?

All Saints Catholic School follows the quarantine guidance outlined below. Note, your child can also be a close contact for exposure outside of school, including if someone else in the home tests positive for COVID.

Is your child...



Fully vaccinated

It has been at least two weeks since the second shot of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one shot of Johnson & Johnson vaccine.



No quarantine required

Monitor symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop. Recommend testing on days 3, 4, or 5.



Had COVID-19

Had a positive COVID-19 test in the last three months, but are no longer in isolation.



No quarantine required

Must submit the positive test result. Monitor for symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop.



No vaccination+

Masks were worn by close contact and COVID positive case+



No quarantine required

Monitor for symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop.



3 to 6 feet social distance*




No vaccination+

Masks were worn by close contact and COVID positive case + 3 feet or less social distance*



Two options

1. Quarantine seven days with a negative test on day six or seven." Return to school on day 8.





No vaccine+ No mask for either close contact or COVID positive case



Two options

- Quarantine for seven days with a negative PCR test on day six or seven. Return to school on day
 Continue to monitor for symptoms for 14 days and stay home and get tested if symptoms develop.
- 2. Quarantine for 10 days and get tested if symptoms develop.
