

HIGHLIGHTS OF 2019-2020







- Thirty-one 7th and 8th grade students were inducted into our chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) at a ceremonial Mass in February, bringing our total to 53 students.
- Over the summer of 2019, we moved our Chapel into a larger space, now allowing for an entire grade to celebrate Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, religion classes, and other worship experiences together.
- Implemented STAR Renaissance computer-assisted standardized testing, at the request of the Archdiocese of Detroit, replacing the IOWA testing program.
- All Saints hosted its annual Lenten Hygiene Drive to benefit the All Saints Food Pantry & Soup Kitchen for much needed toiletry items such as shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, and lotion.
- Our Advent Giving Tree program was another huge success, and our generous community filled a 10-foot U-Haul with more than 600 gifts to help support 115 children through the All Saints Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry in Detroit.
- Added new community-building activities such as Donuts With Dad and Muffins With Mom so our students could share some special family time before heading into class.
- Celebrated the completion of our new back playground, funded in part with generous contributions from our community during our Raise-the-Paddle portion of our March 2019 auction.
- Continued our Virtues in Practice program with the Year of Faith as a way for our pre-kindergarten through 8th grade students to grow closer to Jesus by imitating His life and virtues.
- Expanded our Parents in Prayer program so we have more ways of bringing our community together in prayer.
- Held our first 6th grade overnight camping trip and our second leadership training day for our 7th and 8th grade students to help them gain skills in teamwork and confidence. Both events were at the Howell Nature Center.
- Instituted a new "All Hands on Deck" designated time on Fridays, where students in grades 4 through 8 will receive increased individualized instruction, whether they are struggling or in need of additional curriculum challenges.
- Pivoted from in-person learning to distance learning within days of an unprecedented shutdown due to the global COVID-19 pandemic. Our teachers, staff members, parents, and students rose to the occasion, to continue our commitment to providing our families with an excellent education focused on spiritual and academic growth.

Happening in 2020-2021

- Marshalled unprecedented teamwork to bring students back to in-person instruction following the COVID-19 state-mandated shutdown from March 2020.
- Introduced Year III of the Virtues in Practice program, focusing on the Year of Hope.
- Expanded our school to near-capacity in some grade levels, ensuring a vibrant, strong community focused on mind, body, and spirit.
- Expanded service opportunities for all grades in the school at an age-appropriate level.
