
HIGHLIGHTS OF 2018-2019



- Twenty-eight 7th and 8th grade students were inducted into our chapter of the National Junior Honor Society (NJHS) at a ceremonial Mass in February, bringing our total to 63 students.
- Student averages for the Iowa Assessment met the 78th percentile mark for English language arts for students grades 1-8 (top 22% nationally) and student averages for math met the 72nd percentile mark (top 28% nationally).
- All Saints hosted its annual Lenten Hygiene Drive to benefit the All Saints Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry for much needed toiletry items such as shampoo, toothpaste, deodorant, and lotion. Student council and NJHS members delivered and distributed the items in Detroit.
- Our 14th Annual Grandparents' and Special Persons' Day welcomed more than 500 guests into the building. Visitors spent time touring the school, learning about classroom activities, and making memories with their special student(s).
- Our Advent Giving Tree program was another huge success, and our generous community filled a 10-foot U-Haul with more than 600 gifts to help support 115 children through the All Saints Soup Kitchen and Food Pantry in Detroit.
- Students in the upper hall were paired with younger students as prayer buddies throughout the Lenten season. Older and younger students prayed together and created prayer chains to display outside their classrooms.
- Instituted a campus ministry program, with the addition of a part-time campus minister to lead faith-formation opportunities for students, parents, and staff.
- Began our Virtues in Practice program as a way for our pre-kindergarten through 8th grade students to grow closer to Jesus by imitating His life and virtues.
- During our annual auction, we raised \$16,000 toward our new back playground as part of our Raise-the-Paddle segment.
- Held our first leadership training day for our 7th and 8th grade students to help them gain skills in teamwork and confidence.
- Our All Saints community hosted our first annual Veterans' Day celebration to honor family members, friends, and those in our community who have served our country.
- Our teachers planned culminating activities to make units of study come alive, which included our first-ever 7th grade homage to the Roaring '20s, as well as:
 - Animal Habitat Reports
 - Greek Olympics
 - Renaissance Faire
 - Ellis Island Simulation
 - Native American Feast & Wax Museum

HAPPENING IN 2019-2020

- Over the summer, we moved our Chapel into a larger space, now allowing for an entire grade to celebrate Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, religion classes, and other worship experiences together.
- Celebrated the completion of our new back playground, funded in part with generous contributions from our community during our Raise-the-Paddle portion of our March auction.
- Expansion of our Parents in Prayer program so we have more ways of bringing our community together in prayer.
- Expansion of service opportunities for all grades in the school at an age-appropriate level.
- Implementation of an upgraded security system, as the result of a grant from the State of Michigan.
- Implementation of STAR Renaissance computer-assisted standardized testing, at the request of the Archdiocese of Detroit, replacing the IOWA testing program.
- Introduction of the 6 Traits of Writing program for students in K-6.
- Implementation of the Next Generation of Science standards, focusing on physical science, engineering, life sciences, and earth and space.
- Introduction of Year II of the Virtues in Practice program, focusing on the Year of Faith.
- Institution of a new “All Hands on Deck” designated time on Fridays, where students in grades 4 through 8 will receive increased individualized instruction, whether they are struggling or in need of additional curriculum challenges.
- Adoption of new grade-level experiences:
 - 6th grade overnight camping trip to the Howell Nature Center
 - 7th grade STEM overnight trip to Mackinac Island in May
 - Move-Up Day in March




Fiscal year ending June 30, 2019


